(Living by Faith)

Rom. 15:29 NKJV

But I know that when I come to you, I shall come in the fullness of the blessing of the gospel of Christ.

Matt 14:29-33 NKJV

29 So He said, "Come." And when Peter had come down out of the boat, he walked on the water to go to Jesus. 30 But when he saw that the wind was boisterous, he was afraid; and beginning to sink he cried out, saying, "Lord, save me!" 31 And immediately Jesus stretched out His hand and caught him, and said to him, "O you of little faith, why did you doubt?"

Doubt: the enemy of faith

1. Doubt will counteract your faith

Matt 17:18-20 NKJV

18 And Jesus rebuked the demon, and it came out of him; and the child was cured from that very hour. 19 Then the disciples came to Jesus privately and said, "Why could we not cast it out?" 20 So Jesus said to them, "Because of your unbelief; for assuredly, I say to you, if you have faith as a mustard seed, you will say to this mountain, "Move from here to there," and it will move; and nothing will be impossible for you. 21 However, this kind does not go out except by prayer and fasting."

2. You can believe and have doubt at the same time

3. We must deal with doubt

Mark 5:35-36 NKJV

35 While He was still speaking, some came from the ruler of the synagogue's house who said, "Your daughter is dead. Why trouble the Teacher any further?" 36 As soon as Jesus heard the word that was spoken, He said to the ruler of the synagogue, "Do not be afraid; only believe."

Mark 6:5-6

5 Now He could do no mighty work there, except that He laid His hands on a few sick people and healed them. 6 And He marveled because of their unbelief.

Matt. 17:21

21 However, this kind does not go out except by prayer and fasting.

Doubt Busters

1. Pray & Fast
2. Take some extra time with God
3. Feed your faith
4. Starve your doubt
5. Speak to doubt
6. Replace thoughts of doubt
